



Information for Obstetrical Patients

This information is presented so that you understand our financial policies related to pregnancy and to avoid any unexpected charges being billed to you directly.

- You must present your valid insurance card at every visit.
- It's your responsibility to **notify us immediately** if your insurance coverage changes or stops during your pregnancy and you must present a valid ID card for any new coverage. If we are unable to verify your coverage, you will be considered self-pay.
- If you switch your primary insurance from private to Medicaid or get Medicaid secondary to your primary insurance during your pregnancy, **you will be dismissed as a patient.**
- If we bill Medicaid as your primary insurance and find that you have other primary coverage you did not tell us about, **we will report this as fraud to Medicaid and you will be responsible for the balance.**
- We do not take new patients with Medicaid as their primary or secondary insurance. If you change your insurance prior to your first appointment, your appointment will be cancelled.
- If you obtain Medicaid as secondary coverage during your pregnancy, **it is your responsibility to inform us as soon as it is effective.**
- We bill the insurance information on file at the time of service. **If you fail to give us correct information; we do not make retroactive billing corrections.**
- **If you no show for your appointment, there is a \$75 fee per visit.**
